You will most likely still need to use prescription eyewear or OTC readers for most daily activities.

Corrects astigmatism for sharper, brighter, crisper vision. Premium cataract surgery utilizes our Callisto digital imaging system which allows your ophthalmologist to measure and surgically correct astigmatism. With astigmatism corrected, you will experience sharper, clearer vision, with less halos in low light situations such as night driving. You will most likely still need to use OTC readers for near and intermediate work.
